






Dunkettle Progress Update 16th December 2022






• Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures and CCTV monitoring is in place on site with a particular focus at present

on the N40 westbound approach to the Jack Lynch Tunnel where the new traffic lights have been installed recently.


 The ground improvement works west of Structure ST05 are continuing – see photograph below. We hope to move to embankment construction in this area from January 2023.

• The piling works under the carriageway referenced in last week's update have been completed under night-time working - see

photograph below. These piles will ultimately support a new Retaining Wall, RW03, which will be constructed in this area in 2023.

 Bridge beams at Structure, ST08 will now be placed under night-time working on the nights of Tuesday 20th and Wednesday 21st December 2022 – see photograph below. Localised traffic diversions will be in place. The next beams to be placed will be at Structure, ST03 – details to follow in January 2023.

- During week commencing Monday 19th December 2022, there will be a focus on closing up the site for the holiday period. We will be closing the site on Friday 23rd December 2022, and it will reopen on Tuesday 3rd January 2023. The site will be monitored on a daily basis throughout the holiday period.
