
### **Dunkettle Interchange Project - Advance Works**

Upgrade Dunkettle to a largely free-flow interchange to alleviate traffic congestion.




 As shown in the photograph above, embankment construction and general earthworks are ongoing in the area immediately west of the M8 and north of the N25. This area will ultimately become a free flow slip road from the N8 to the M8 towards Dublin and a pedestrian/cycleway will also be constructed. Works in this area will continue until May 2020.

- Preparatory works for the reinforced concrete protection slab to protect a length
  of the existing gas transmission are continuing south of the N25 near the Pfizer
  northern boundary.
- Watermain works in the North Esk area of the site will recommence on Monday 20th January 2020 and continue for 3 - 4 weeks. The purpose of these works is to divert the existing 600mm diameter watermain away from the line of the proposed new interchange alignment.
- Installation of service ducting is continuing throughout the site and this element of the works will continue until Easter 2020. At present the focus is on the N25 eastbound and westbound and the focus will switch to the Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout area itself over the coming days. In order to minimise disruption to traffic, on-line works under this heading are being progressed under night time lane closures between 10pm and 5am on each night from Monday to Thursday inclusive.
- The photograph below shows duct installation works progressing on the N25 eastbound off-slip to Glounthaune under night time traffic management arrangements.
- Further details of the works above and additional upcoming works will continue to be provided via the weekly updates.
