Dunkettle Interchange Project

Upgrade Dunkettle to a largely free-flow interchange to alleviate traffic congestion.

- In the area North of the Pfizer plant, piling works have been completed and pile heads are currently being exposed. Works here are likely to continue until December 2020 but with no disruption to traffic anticipated. See photograph below.

- Rock material will be delivered to site for a number of weeks, starting from Tuesday 27th October, 2020. Access to site will be via the new roundabout on the R623 Little Island Regional Road and no disruption to traffic is anticipated.
- Website information , <https://www.dunkettle.ie/> will be updated over the early days of next week to take account of recent developments on the Scheme.
- We understand that the East Cliff Road will be closed to traffic during daylight hours on Tuesday 27th to facilitate final surfacing works and diversions will be signposted.

N40 Intelligent Transport Systems

Installation of gantry mounted Variable Message Signs and other infrastructure to display traffic information such as journey times.

- Works at the three locations between the Jack Lynch Tunnel and Bloomfield Interchange will continue under hard shoulder closures , with no disruption to traffic anticipated.
- Additional Variable Message Signs on the N40 will “Go Live” over the coming weeks and additional ITS equipment will be installed at the various locations over the coming months.
- We understand that the Jack Lynch Tunnel will be reduced to 1 lane in each direction in a contraflow arrangement over the Bank Holiday weekend from 9pm on today, Friday 23rd October to 5am on Tuesday 27th October and motorists are urged to take particular note of temporary signage in the area. The contraflow arrangement is being implemented to facilitate maintenance works.
