

Dunkettle Progress Update 16th March 2022





We are sending this weeks newsletter today as it is the last working day ahead of the Bank Holiday weekend with works resuming on site at the normal starting time next Monday morning.




The bridge beams were successfully placed at Structure St05 as planned under night time working last night Tuesday 15th March 2022 – see photograph below.

The last remaining section of the bridge deck for Structure St01 alongside the N25 westbound was poured this week. This bridge will

be opened to site construction traffic in the coming weeks – see photograph below.

Works on the cycleway on the L2998 between Burys Bridge and Dunkettle are progressing well and are on track for the due completion date of May 2022 – see photograph below.



Works ongoing for the new cycleway on the L2998.


From Monday 21st March 2022 there will be a significant focus on works in the area of the Link U tie-in to the N8 eastbound – area highlighted on the aerial photo below. This will involve a combination of night time and weekend working along with day time lane closures on

the N8 eastbound – details to follow in next weeks update. At the end of this process, we still hope to open Link U to traffic before the middle of April 2022.

Installation of gantry mounted Variable Message Signs and other infrastructure to display traffic information such as journey times.
