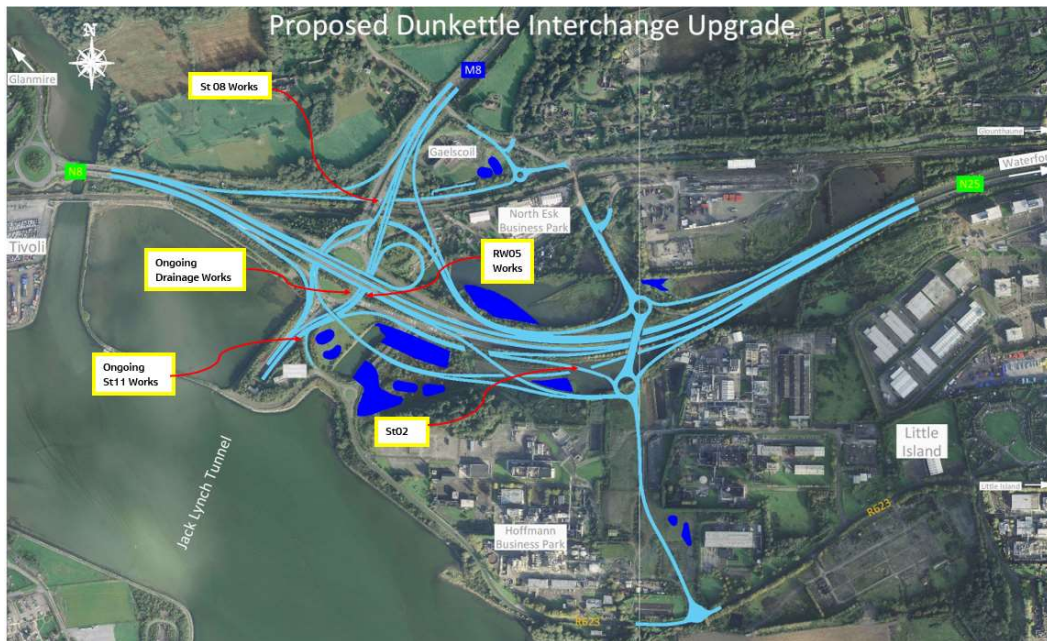

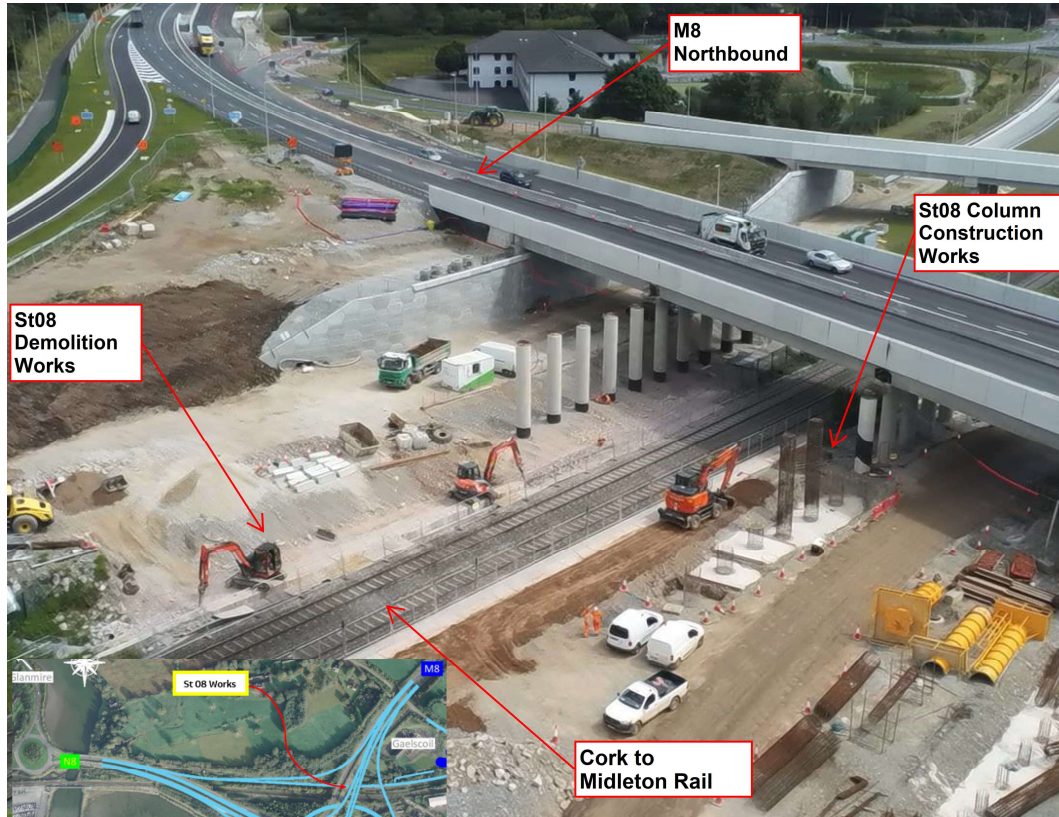
- Works are continuing across the site at all remaining structures and embankment construction areas.

- At Structure St02 alongside the N25 westbound, the works are currently concentrated at the northern abutment where both sets of wingwalls are now complete – see photograph below.

- At Structure St08, alongside the Cork to Midleton railway line, the final phase of the demolition of the existing structure is underway at the northern side. The columns for the central pier at the southern side are also being progressed – see photograph below.

- Commuters on the N40 southbound approach to the Jack Lynch Tunnel will have noticed that the works for Structure St11 are now underway at the point of the diverge to the R623 to Little Island. The existing wall will be demolished and realigned as part of these works in order to allow for the new carriageway layout for the scheme – see photograph below.

- Drainage Works are being progressed within the central island of the Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout along with the completion of Retaining Wall, RW05 – see photograph below.



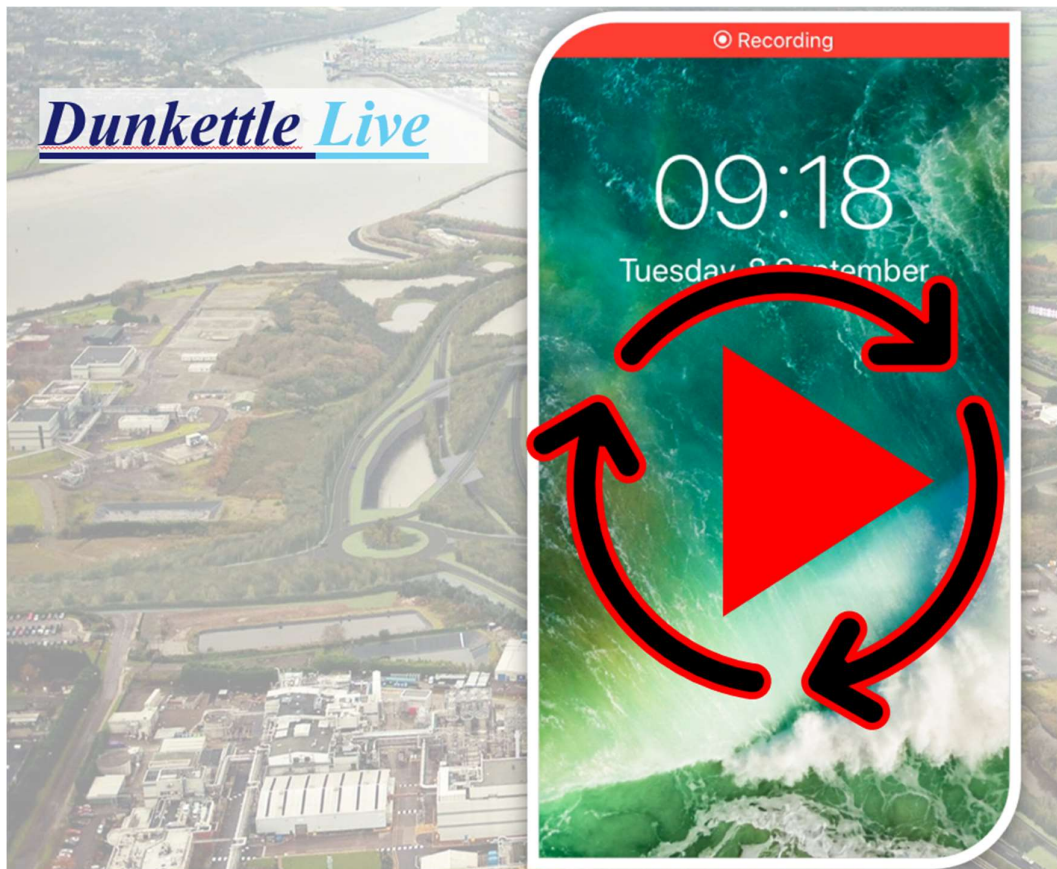

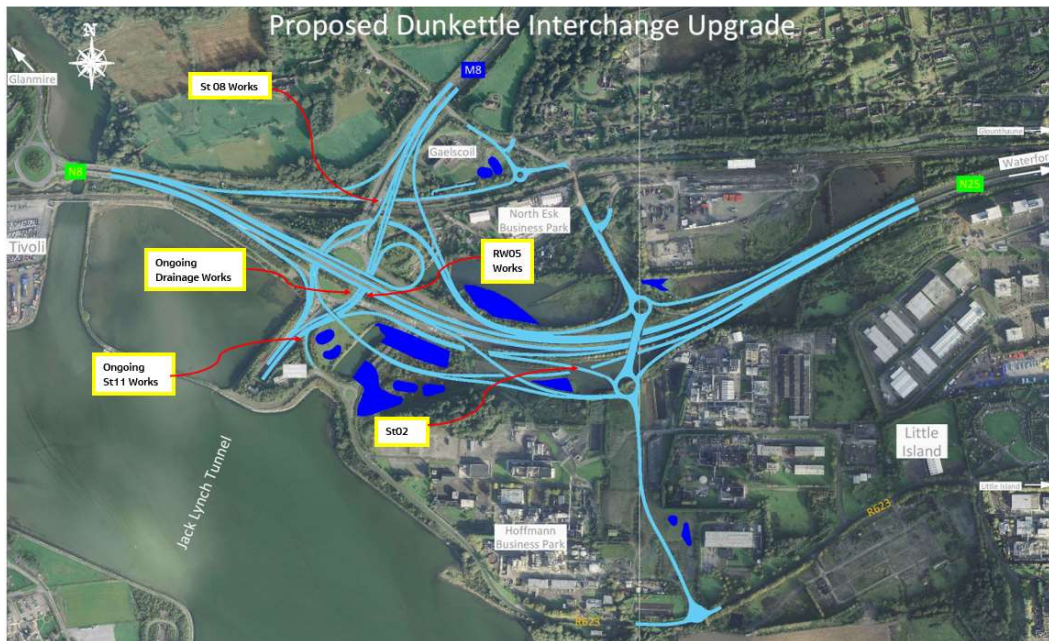

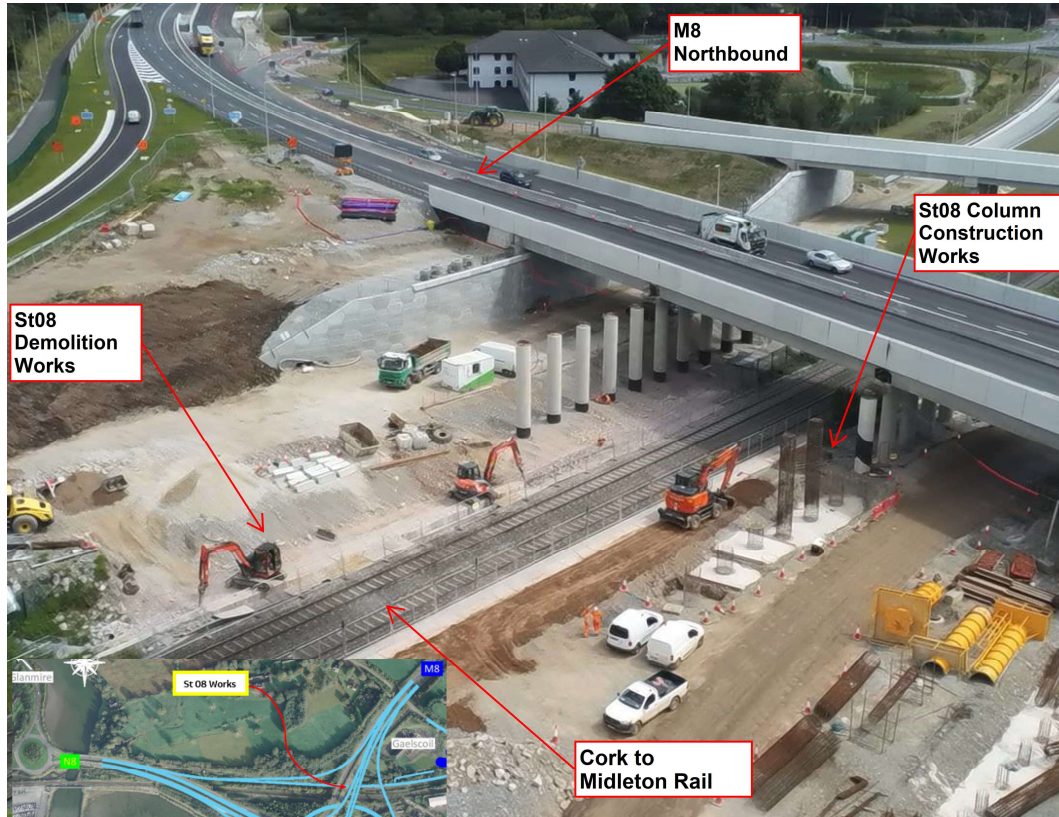

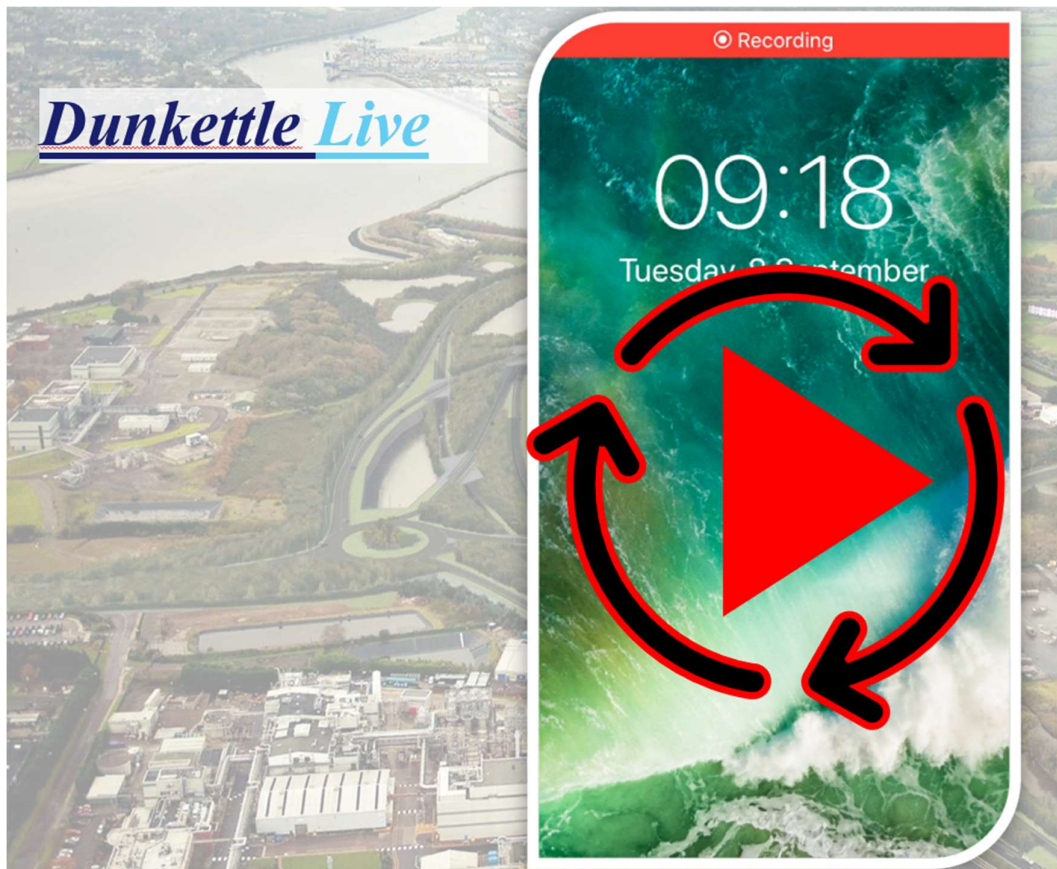
