




Dunkettle Progress Update o9th September 2022








 The speed control van will remain on site on a full time basis over the coming weeks Over the coming period there will be a significant focus on works at the northern side of the Jack Lynch Tunnel:

- The tunnel will be closed in a southbound direction from 21:00 to 04:00 each night from Monday 12th to Friday 16th September 2022.
- Additionally the tunnel will be closed in a northbound direction on Monday 12th and Friday 16th September 2022 only. This will again be from 21:00 to 04:00 each night.
- Temporary surfacing will be in place on the N40 southbound approach to the tunnel in the area marked on the aerial photo below from the morning of Tuesday 13th September 2022 and this will remain in place for a number of months.
- A gantry supporting advance directional signage for the N40 northbound traffic leaving the Jack Lynch Tunnel will be erected on Monday 12th September 2022. The gantry itself is currently being assembled off line – see photograph below.




Location of the upcoming pavement works on the N40 southbound.

 A further gantry will be installed on the N25 eastbound in the area marked on the photograph below. These works will necessitate a closure of the N25 eastbound on Tuesday 13th September 2022 from 21:00 to 05:00. Traffic heading eastbound will be diverted north through Glanmire and back to the Dunkettle Interchange via the M8 southbound.

 The N25 westbound will be closed on Wednesday 14th September 2022 from 21:00 to 05:00 from the Cobh Cross Interchange to the Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout. Traffic will be diverted via the L3004 through Glounthaune.

 Motorists will notice an increased focus on surfacing works on site over the coming weeks and we hope to open further link roads to traffic before the end of 2022 – further details to follow in future updates
