







Dunkettle Progress Update 07th October 2022





• Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures are in place across the site on a continuous basis over the coming weeks.

• The configuration of the N25 westbound diverge approach (Link K) to the Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout will be adjusted over the coming period. The proposed new alignment in this area is shown on the photo below. There will be a new set of traffic lights in place along the new alignment to cater for this adjustment. The purpose of the adjustment in this area is to facilitate access for ground improvement works in the area immediately west of Structure St05.

• Traffic Management measures remain in place on the northbound lanes between the Jack Lynch Tunnel and the Interchange Roundabout. The works to construct the new retaining wall are continuing – see photograph below. These works are adding to delays at peak times and the works will continue over the coming weekend with a view to minimising this disruption. The scope of the Traffic Management measures is being reduced as the works are progressed and we hope that these Traffic Management arrangements will be substantially removed by Friday 21st October 2022.

 In relation to Bridge Structures, works are continuing at Structures St02, St03 & St04 alongside the N25 westbound – see photograph below.

 The recently constructed roundabout on the R623 access to Little Island from the N40 will be closed from 19:00 tonight Friday 7th October until 18:00 tomorrow Saturday 8th October 2022. Traffic will be diverted via the Little Island Flyover and the N25 in both directions. These works are required in order to tie into the new Link Road Q – see photograph below.

 Motorists are requested to take particular care over the coming months while layout changes are implemented at various locations. The construction focus overall will continue to be on online areas and areas immediately adjacent to existing traffic lanes.
