






## Dunkettle Progress Update

## 04th November 2022





• Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures will be in place across the site on a continuous basis over the coming weeks

 The aerial shot below shows the works at Structure ST11 - the new Jack Lynch Tunnel retaining walls, progressing towards completion. As noted in last week's update, we still hope to fully remove the temporary traffic management (associated with the crane) from this area during W/C 7th November 2022.



Works ongoing adjacent to the N40 northbound between the Jack Lynch Tunnel & Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout.

 Works are continuing at Structures St02, St03 & St04 south of the N25 westbound. We hope to complete all of these structures by early 2023 – see photograph below.

• The M8 southbound will revert to two lanes before the end of this month – see photograph below.




The M8 southbound approach to the Dunkettle Interchange.
