



Dunkettle Progress Update 03rd February 2023







 Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures, coupled with CCTV monitoring are in place across the site and will remain in place over the coming months. Unfortunately, the opening of Link I has been delayed slightly to allow time for the completion of the pedestrian / cyclist traffic lightcontrolled crossing point. We now expect that this link will open to traffic during W/C Tuesday 7th February 2022 – see photographs below.

• We now propose to construct the gantry base for the proposed portal directional signage at the southern side of the interchange roundabout circulating carriageway over the coming days. Accordingly, while the Retaining Wall RW03 works have reached completion at this location for the time being, the localised lane restriction on the N40 northbound immediate approach to the interchange roundabout will remain in place for another week or so approximately – see photograph below. No significant disruption to traffic is anticipated as a result of the same.

 We now intend to place the bridge beams at Structure ST04 during daytime working hours on Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th February 2023 with a 5am start each morning. These works are offline and should cause no disruption to traffic but they will be very visible to motorists on the N25 westbound in particular - see photograph below.

 Surfacing works will be focused on the N25 median area and the N25 westbound for a number of weeks starting from Tuesday 7th February 2023 – see below photograph of the ongoing preparatory work for the same.
