






## Dunkettle Progress Update 10th March 2023






• Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures, coupled with CCTV monitoring are in place across the site and will remain in place over the coming months.

• Steel fixing works for Structures ST03 & ST04 are progressing well on site – see photograph below. Dates for the casting of these bridge decks will be established over the coming period.



Steel fixing works ongoing on site for Structures ST03 & ST04 alongside the N25 westbound.

 The bridge deck waterproofing of the existing structures at the Interchange Roundabout, Structures ST17 & ST18 (as highlighted on the layout plan above) is being renewed as part of the Dunkettle Interchange Works – see photograph below. This waterproofing renewal will also be carried out at Structures ST14 & ST15 as per the layout plan above.

Surfacing works this week have been mainly focused offline on Link
F which will ultimately form the new free flow link form the N8 eastbound to the Jack Lynch Tunnel – see photograph below.

 Over the coming weeks, the focus from a surfacing point of view will be mainly on the N25 central median area and also on the proposed new link roads south of the N25 Links C, K & J – see photograph below.
