








Dunkettle Progress Update

10th November 2023






• From next Monday (W/C 13/11/23), there will be a focus on the completion of surfacing works in a number of areas of the site. These works will be progressed under night-time working, in order to minimise disruption to traffic, and the areas to be completed include the area immediately North of the Jack Lynch Tunnel in both directions – see photograph below

• The section of the concrete parapet railing over the Cork to Cobh railway line was successfully completed during the period – see photograph below. We hope to complete the full extent of the concrete parapet railing by Friday 17th November 2023.

 The main focus will continue to be on the completion of Link C. At present, construction of the reinforced concrete Retaining Wall, RW03 is ongoing along with the completion of the remaining earthworks for Link C in the area east of Structure ST05 – see photograph below.


• In overall terms, works remain on target for completion by Feb 2024.
